

NOTICE: SUMMARY OF 2018 FEES AND CHARGES



Kindergarten Registration Fee: A payment contributing to administrative costs associated with the processing of a child’s enrolment application for a place in a program at the service.

Kindergarten Enrolment Fee: This fee must be paid by parents/guardians when accepting an offer of a kindergarten place. This payment is retained and deducted from Term 1 fees. Payment will secure the child’s place in the kindergarten program.

Kindergarten Program Fee: The Department of Education and Training (DET) provides per capita funding as a contribution toward the costs of providing a four-year-old kindergarten program. GKA meets the balance of costs through charging fees. Three-year-old kindergarten is funded exclusively by parent fees.

3 Year Old Program Fees – 3 Hours per week	\$246.00 per term
3 Year Old Program Fees – 4 Hours per week	\$328.00 per term
3 Year Old Program Fees – 4.5 Hours per week	\$369.00 per term
3 Year Old Program Fees – 5 Hours per week	\$410.00 per term
3 Year Old Program Fees – 6 Hours per week	\$492.00 per term

Kindergarten Fee Subsidy: Families who are eligible for the Kindergarten Fee Subsidy will not be required to pay fees. It is the responsibility of the family to ensure BKS has been provided with current proof of Kindergarten Fee Subsidy eligibility.

Child Care Benefit (CCB): Bi annual Child Care Benefit receipts will be issued upon request.

Late Collection Charge: GKA reserves the right to implement a late collection charge when parents/guardians are frequently late in collecting a child.
